If builders have any problem sites that may be vulnerable please let investigators know so

extra attention can be paid to the site in that area.

It is important to ensure all sites are as clean as possible as well as making certain that both site sheds and houses are locked preventing children from having an opportunity to cause damage.

Holiday Crime Prevention Tips

1. Ensure your sites are secure, check all doors, windows and site sheds are locked. Don't leave it up to the tradesmen!!
2. Move all unused building material to the rear of site out of view from the road.
3. To avoid any site damage ensure all loose materials and bricks are cleared.
4. Ensure all Name and Shame site signage is fully visible from the road.
5. Distribute Name and Shame flyers to houses in the immediate area of problem sites to ensure the community are aware of the campaign.
