Name and Shame Investigators have recently been doing random site visits to campaign members.

On these visits investigators have noticed a lot of sites containing white goods being left unlocked.

We urge supervisors to ensure that all trades people are reminded to secure sites when leaving the premises

This strategy will go a long way in reducing building site crime.

Thieves Target Display Homes

The year kicked off with a group of offenders targeting eight display homes from Butler to Southern River over a two week period.

The thieves targeted plasma screens and, caused extensive damage in the process.

Forensic examination of the sites resulted in two adults and two juveniles charged with over 15 offences relating to the burglaries on display homes and building sites.

This is an excellent results by the police as locating the offenders in this short period of time stopped the offenders rampage from continuing.

There are several Plasmas fitted with GPS tracking devices throughout the metro area, however on this occasion none of these display homes were targeted. Name and Shame investigators are continuing their efforts to source affordable GPS tracking options to enhance security.

Theft Reduced

The continuing value of the Name and Shame campaign is highlighted below in the latest statistics with a **55%** reduction in the reported theft of internal whitegoods over the last 4 years.

In 2006 there was 243 reported incidents with a total value of \$211, 568

During 2007, 215 incidents with a total value of \$180, 791 were reported.

Then 2008 improved further with 178 reported incidents having a total value of \$158, 492.

Finally last year saw an even bigger reduction of only 107 reported incidents with a total of \$88, 592.

As these statistics show the campaign is providing great results and growing stronger as the years progress, due to the continual support of our members.
