## The Guide to Best Practice

The campaign has been working on a best practice guide for companies to assist the building industry to change an entrenched culture that theft from building sites is acceptable. Members should both promote and maintain a No Tolerance Policy in relation to building site crime.

This guide will introduce measures to ensure that preventative strategies are implemented so that the industry can play its part in reducing the opportunities of building site crime.

The manual provides a simple checklist that summarises the guide and lists the steps needed to be taken to reduce the opportunity of crime on sites.



If all members ensure that the checklist is undertaken on a regular basis, you can be assured that you are minimising the opportunity for crime on site.

## CAUGHT!!

Police have charged a male and female for two counts of aggravated burglary as well as two counts of stealing in the Cloverdale area. The offenders were caught when Name and Shame investigators followed up on information provided by a member of the public.

Subsequent to this call investigator's conducted a thorough search of the site and found that offenders had removed wall tiles and wooden doors from the premises.

Further investigation then located trolley tracks in the sand which were then isolated for Forensic Officers to examine. Investigators then undertook a door knock in the area and were able to locate an eye witness who gave a detailed statement of the offence.

With this information police were able to obtain a search warrant for the offender's premises where they located the stolen goods. The goods were then returned to the builder and the offenders were charged with burglary and stealing.
